

FORD 2005 MOUNTAIN BIKE RACE SERIES - STONY CREEK MARATHON
Saturday July 2, 2005 - Ford NORBA MI State Championship Series Race #4 of 8

THE DETAILS

This Marathon XC Race is held under NORBA rules. Annual NORBA License IS REQUIRED ONLY FOR ELITE AND EXPERT Classes.

Sport & Beginner Classes DO NOT require any special Licensing or fees. NORBA licenses may be purchased at this event.

This event is a NORBA Marathon Cross Country format race. The race will be set up with 2 different distances, Elite and Expert classes will race approximately 62 miles while Sport and Beginner classes will race approximately 40 miles. Each loop will be about 10 miles long, and will be different from our traditional Cross Country or Time Trial loops.

Racing begins at 11:00 am: Elites go first, then Experts, then all Sport classes, and then all Beginner classes.

Registration & race start will be at West Branch Picnic area, Pavilion C. Registration will open at 9:30 am.

Series Points for Overall Series Standings: *This event is one of two series events that can be worth DOUBLE POINTS.* We will score your best finish from this event or the Whiskey Creek Stage Race as DOUBLE Points, and the other will revert to SINGLE points.

Prize Money and Awards:

Elite Men \$660 – 1st \$200, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$100, 4th \$75, 5th \$60, 6th \$45, 7th \$30
Expert/Elite Women \$350 – 1st \$125, 2nd \$90, 3rd \$60, 4th \$45, 5th \$30
All other classes will award Medals to Top 5 Finishers.

Ford NORBA State Championship XC Series will tabulate best 5 point scores out of the 8 Series events to determine Overall Series Placing.

Ford-NORBA Overall Series Champion in each Category/Age Group receives *Invitation & Free Entry* into the **Iceman Cometh Challenge** Nov 5 to compete in the First Mountain Bike Regional Invitational for the Midwest! This Regional event will be based on Iceman finishes, and the racers from Michigan, Indiana, Ohio, Wisconsin & Illinois will compete for Top Regional Honors.
