the Bishop Lake Campground entrance).

From Ann Arbor: Take US-23 north to M-36 (Exit 54-B, approx. 12 miles from Ann Arbor). Go west on M-36 to Chilson Road (4.8 mi) and turn right. Take Chilson 3.8 mi to Bishop Lk Rd and turn right. Go 1-1/2 mi to Bishop Lake Entrance (go past Campground entr.).
