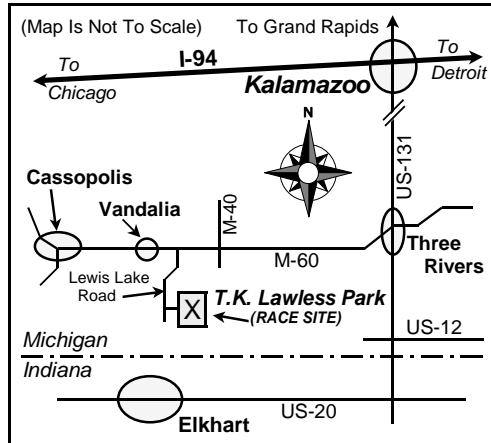


T.K. LAWLESS PARK

T.K. Lawless County Park is located south and west of Kalamazoo. From I-94, take US-131 south toward Three Rivers. Go approx. 20 miles, and at the 'Y' take M-60 west about 12 miles towards Vandalia. Turn left (south) onto Lewis Lake Rd., go to Monkey Run St. and turn left (east) and take it directly to the park.

Note: \$2/Car parking fee will be collected.



COURSE INFORMATION

A completely rideable loop of fun technical singletrack filled with the same familiar hills and switchbacks as usual but with more passing areas. We are adding some challenging hills and wide open trails to expand the loop from 11 miles to approximately 14 miles for this event.

Elite Racers	10:01-10:14
Expert Racers	10:15-10:44
Sport Racers	10:45-11:29
Beginner Racers	11:30-12:14
Tand./Single Spd.	12:15-12:30

Pre-Registered racers start first, then Day-Of racers start in the order they register in (still within their Category Start Time Block).

All Racers (Pre-Registered & Day-Of) Start Within Their Category Start Time Blocks
Note: Start Time Blocks may be different at other Time Trial locations (see race flyers).

Riders start Two At A Time at 30 second intervals.
