## Directions to Stony Creek MetroPark in Shelby Township, MI:

To look up directions to the park on a mapping program, use the following address information: 4300 Main Park Rd, Shelby Township, MI, 48316.

**Stony Creek Park** is North of Utica & East of Rochester, Michigan. Take M-59 to M-53 and go north to 26 Mile Road. Go west on 26 Mile Rd past Mound Road and follow the signs to the left into the park. **OR ALTERNATELY**, You can take M-59 to Dequindre Rd and go north to 25 Mile Rd (Runyan Rd). Turn right (east) on 25 Mile and go about 1 mile to Shelby Rd. Turn Left (north) and follow the signs into the park.

MASTERS 35+, MASTERS 45+, ELITE WOMEN (CX-1, 2, 3)

**Race-4** starts at 1:30p (60 minute race)
