
BRIGHTON RECREATION AREA

To get to the park: Take I-96 to the Brighton Exit (#147) and go through Downtown Brighton. Main Street in Brighton becomes Brighton Road outside of town. Take Brighton Road west 5 miles to Chilson Road. Turn left and go 1-1/2 miles to Bishop Lake Road (a dirt road) and turn left again. Go 1-1/2 miles to the *Bishop Lake Entrance* (go past the Bishop Lake Campground entrance).

From Ann Arbor: Take US-23 north to M-36 (Exit 54-B, approx. 12 miles from A-Arbor). Go west on M-36 to Chilson Road (4.8 mi) and turn right. Take Chilson 3.8 mi to Bishop Lk Rd and turn right. Go 1-1/2 mi to Bishop Lake Entrance (go past Campground Ent).



Park entry is \$4 per car if you do not

have an annual State Park Vehicle Permit (Annual Permit is \$20).

COURSE INFORMATION

The race course is a nicely flowing 12 mile loop using the Penosha and long Murray Lake Trails. It has a challenging combination of single track and fast two-track with some short climbs thrown in for good measure. *All racers ride once around the same loop*.
