

This Time Trial will use the Green Loop combined with much of the familiar (and much loved!) Red Loop traditional trail. The race course is a challenging 13 mile loop that is about 75% singletrack with plenty of passing areas. It includes many of your favorite sections like the Trenches and Granny's Garden that have become the hallmark of the Ft. Custer trail system. **All racers do one complete loop.**

# 2009 USAC MTB MICHIGAN STATE CHAMPIONSHIP XC RACE SERIES

Nine Mountain Bike races make up the USAC MTB Michigan State Championship Cross Country Race Series.

Elite and Expert Classes require USAC-MTB Annual License for participation while Sport and Beginner Classes **DO NOT**. Annual License may be purchased at race or on-line at the USA Cycling web site: www.usacycling.org

All participants have their points tabulated for **Overall Series Standings.** If you are the Overall Series Champion in your Age Group/Category, you win a **FREE ENTRY** to the **2009 ICEMAN!** 

If you hold an Annual USAC-MTB License, you will also earn the USAC STATE CHAMPION Title and Medal (awarded to Top 3 places in each Class/Category, based on Overall Series Standings). We total the 6 highest point scores out of the 9 Series Races for each participant to determine the Overall Series Standings.

Note that the Brighton Stage Race (May 30/31) and the Stony Creek Marathon XC (June 27) are each DOUBLE POINTS events. For Overall Series scoring, ONLY ONE out of these two events will be counted as DOUBLE POINTS for each racer, the other (the lower finish out of these two events) counts SINGLE POINTS towards Series Standings. All points stay in the class in which they are earned. You must start 3 races in your Class/Category to be eligible for Overall Series Awards.
